#### **RENUNCIATION of Sin and Profession of Faith**

The pastor addresses the parents & other sponsors: On behalf of the whole church, I ask you:

Do you renounce the spiritual forces of wickedness, reject the evil powers of this world, and repent of your sin? *I do.* 

Do you accept the freedom and power God gives you to resist evil, injustice, and oppression in whatever forms they present themselves?

I do.

Do you confess Jesus Christ as your Savior, put your whole trust in his grace, and promise to serve him as your Lord, in union with the church which Christ offers to people of all ages, nations, and races?

I do.
