Read the Gospel of Matthew or the entire New Testament in 40 Days!

Lent? The Lenten season? What is that?

Lent is a very special time of the Christian year. Each year it is the 40 day period (excluding Sundays) leading up to Easter. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Lenten season (which comes from the old Saxon word for "spring").

In the early Church, Lent marked the final 40 days of a new Christian's preparation for full entry into the Church prior to their baptism on Easter Sunday. As time went on, this annual time of reflection and repentance was extended to all Church members, giving all of us the chance to re-dedicate ourselves to the spiritual decisions we've made in the past.

Spending the 40 days of Lent reading God's Word

Jesus every day!

This year, one of the ways Immanuel Church of Spring is encouraging its members to recognize Lent is through a renewed commitment to reading the Bible. Members can choose to either read through the Gospel of Matthew or the entire New Testament during the 40 days between Ash Wednesday and Easter Sunday. Reading the Gospel of Matthew over a 40 day period will take (on average) about 5 minutes per day, while reading the whole New Testament will take about 30 minutes.

What do I need? ☐ The Reading Plan (on opposite side of page) The left column has the date, the center column has the assigned reading for the Gospel of Matthew, and the right column has the reading for the New Testament. ☐ The Bible Use a translation that's easy for you to understand. Immanuel Church uses the NRSV in our worship services, but feel free to explore and choose a version that works for you. You can explore some on the YouVersion app or www.biblegateway.com \square A prayerful heart, ready and expecting God to show you some wonderful things. What do I do? □ Set aside 5 - 30 minutes to read the Bible each day. *CAUTION: this may require logging off of* Facebook and Twitter and turning off the television. \Box Pray. Ask God to open your eyes, ears and heart to what He has prepared for you as you read each day. ☐ Read the assigned section each day. Listen for God's voice as you read! \square Put an X or checkmark in the box when you finish that day's reading. ☐ Celebrate and worship on Sunday! There are no assigned readings, so feel free to rest or use it as a catch-up day if you need to. □ Invite someone (a family member, friend or neighbor) to join you. No matter what goal or challenge is before you, it's always easier when you have someone to cheer you on, hold you accountable, and take the adventure with you. ☐ Share what God is showing you!
