

SNAKEBITE PROTOCOL

Time is life! Memorize this Snakebite Protocol!

- Remain calm
- Ensure safety by getting away from the snake
- Do not catch or kill the snake
- Call for medical assistance
- Immediately apply a pressure bandage for neurotoxic bites
- If a Pressure Bandage is unavailable, a tourniquet can be applied above the bite site if the responsible snake has been correctly identified as a Black Mamba or a Cape Cobra and you are more than 90 minutes from hospital
- Immobilize the affected limb to prevent movement
- Rinse venom out of the eyes with water



• Ensure quick transportation to the hospital

• Where possible call ahead to inform the hospital that you are on the way

DO NOT:

- Do not cut into the wound
- Do not try and suck venom from the wound
- Do not give the victim alcohol or pain medication
