

## Be safe! Be professional!

# 1

- Ensure that you have the correct PPE
- Ensure that you have the correct handling equipment
- Remain calm
- Contact a First Aider to accompany you

# 2

- Ensure area is safe
- Look out for bystanders and animals like dogs
- Anticipate any obstacles during the capture

# 3

- Don't put your hands where you can't see when trying to capture the snake
- Capture the snake in a professional and safe manner

# 4

- Ensure the container is escape-proof
- Ensure the container is adequately marked as dangerous
- Release the snake as soon as possible in a safe and acceptable area
- Report the capture to the Safety Officer



**DO NOT:**  
**Do not pick up any snake with your hands that you can not identify!**
