

Don't Let Overspending Steal Your Christmas Joy

Yes, here we are, at one of the most exciting times of the year – on the brink of the Christmas holiday. Are you prepared spiritually, what about financially? Well, if you're like a lot of people, you didn't consider the holiday when you planned your annual budget at the beginning of the year. While the whole point of the holiday is to commemorate the birth of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, the celebration often includes buying presents, decorating our homes, having family gatherings, or maybe even traveling. You know it's coming, every year at the same time, yet you find yourself caught off guard and short of cash, again. Christmas Club Accounts help you automatically save money all year to make the holiday feel a lot more affordable and to help limit your spending.

While Christmas clubs aren't as popular as they used to be, they are still a viable and easy way to ensure you aren't maxing out your credit cards in December. Many banks and most credit unions still offer Christmas (or Holiday) Club accounts, which allow you to automatically transfer a certain amount of money from each paycheck to a savings account that's been earmarked for holiday spending. You can start now (most financial institutions' Christmas Club accounts run from Nov to Nov), and make regular (weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly) deposits in the account. You don't touch the money until the end of the Christmas Club account term.

Decide who you want to buy gifts for and how much you want to spend on each person, your food and entertainment costs if you're hosting dinner, decorations, or travel expenses if visiting family. Once you've estimated your total Christmas expenses, you'll know how much you need to save. If you get paid bi-weekly, you'll have to divide the total expenses by 26. This is the amount you want to set up as automatic transfers from each paycheck to your Christmas Club account.

The benefits of Christmas Club accounts are they take very little discipline because you don't see the money leaving. They offer slightly higher interest rates than traditional savings accounts (but the interest earned isn't great). They lock up your money through the maturity date making it harder to nibble on. A Christmas Club account keeps holiday savings separate from other savings. And you can save a little each payday until you reach your goal, lessening the financial burden and impact on your finances.



Keep in mind this hack won't solve all your financial woes, but it is a step in the right direction. It will help you develop the practice of setting aside money and allow you to fund the holiday with cash as opposed to using credit cards. 
MODELING CAREER

My mother's spiritual experience began around 28 years old when the Lord began to draw her attention to Him. He began to speak to her heart about forsaking the world and following Him. She was a beautiful woman with extraordinary looks which led her to pursue a modeling career in the 1960's. Producers and agents were selecting her for modeling engagements attended by senators, ambassadors, and other well-known people. She was modeling for top designers in runway shows, photo shoots, commercials, and newspapers, and she even began doing beer company ads. Her talents and beauty catapulted her to centerfold and cover girl for popular magazines and publications. She even garnered a business deal with a Washington, DC television station to have my oldest sister's birthday celebration broadcast live on air.

One of the highlights of her career was gracing the cover of the August 1965 edition of TAN magazine. TAN later became EBONY, the iconic African-American publication, which featured Dorothy Dandridge, Harry Belafonte, and many other notable African-Americans. Having graced TAN magazine, she was considered one of the top African-American models in the country. Her salary increased to a whopping \$75.00 per hour (the minimum hourly wage during this time averaged ~\$1.40). She was well on her way to fame and fortune, but Almighty God had another plan for her life.

My mother was now top-billing at shows and events; she was meeting many celebrities and enjoying the world and all its pleasures. However, the Spirit of God began getting her attention, calling her to forsake the world and serve Him. Several of her female friends in their twenties, began dying unexpectedly, which frightened my mom. As a result, she began attending church with my siblings and me, but without my dad. However, she was still drawn to the world and the allure of success, so she put off serving God. She began to make excuses and asked the Lord for another year of success, which He granted through His amazing grace. After that year passed and



she turned thirty, my mother asked God for yet more time in the world and more success; but the Lord said to her "If I give you another year in the world you will ask me for another year and you will continue in sin." He told her that her time serving the world was over! She was forced to look directly at Jesus' question: "For what shall it profit a man if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?" (Mark 8:36)

AMAZING GRACE ENCOUNTER

My mother and I would spend countless hours talking about the goodness and power of God. Then one day before she passed away she wanted to share her testimony with me. She stated: "My son, now I would like to share the experience I had with the Lord Jesus Christ when I was 30 years of age". I was elated to hear my mother's story and I listened attentively without distraction. She began to share that at the pinnacle of her successful modeling career, one evening at church, she had an encounter with the Lord Jesus Christ. She began to attend several churches around the city but none of them were meeting her spiritual needs. The Spirit of God instructed her to visit the church of her uncle, who was a pastor in Washington, DC. As my gorgeous mother entered this church with her slim figure and fine clothes Sunday after Sunday, the Lord saw something different, a sinner who would become a saint of God. She told me that during this time, she was self-righteous, and sophisticated and didn't enjoy loud worship services. As a matter of fact, she thought people were acting when they praised and worshipped under the power of the Holy Ghost.

One Sunday, my mother walked down the aisle to stand at the altar. While standing there she had a divine encounter with the Lord Jesus Christ. God touched her, and she fell under the anointing of the

power of the Holy Ghost. The amazing part of this encounter is the pastor, nor any other minister, neither laid hands on her nor was praying over her, but the Lord was doing great work in her all on His own! She was experiencing being slain in the Spirit of God. While under the power of God she

could hear the pastor saying "This work is of God leave her alone."

While under the power of God, my mother could not move any part of her body, she was paralyzed. Her spirit was out of her body looking down at her. She was conscious but did not understand what she was experiencing in the spiritual realm. Then she saw the Lord Jesus Christ standing in the corner of the church with a white robe and she saw His hands and became overwhelmed by His presence. While in His presence, she began to feel an excruciating unbearable pain, like needles being thrust into her entire body. The Lord spoke directly to her and said "This pain you are feeling is the pain I felt when I was being crucified on the cross for the sin of the world. I am causing your body to become dead to sin." The pain was unbearable and out of her control. The Lord spoke His

purpose to my mother and said she would have to suffer for Him for 5 years so He could prepare her for her calling.

HER CALLING

After the Lord completed the work of salvation, purging, and deliverance, He filled her with the Holy Ghost evidenced by her speaking in tongues. She said that night the Lord did a completed work on her. She was transformed from a sinner to a saint of God, and she was sold out to the Lord Jesus. After this miraculous encounter, the Lord began to use her in the ministry of healing, miracles, and deliverance. The Lord would allow her to lay hands on people who were sick, demon-possessed and afflicted. She would pray for them and the power of God would come upon them. She performed many miracles, signs, and wonders and became a prayer warrior, evangelist, overseer, and servant of God. Many people sought her for prayer, healing, and other requests and God would work divine miracles through her. Her healing ministry was well known, and people called her from all over the United States, as she used her anointing to the glory of God. People who knew my mother, still talk today about her ministry and fellowship with the Lord.

The hour she lay dying, my oldest sister and I were in the room with her and witnessed the glory of God enter the room to receive her soul and spirit. In her bed, she lifted her arms, and the room was filled with the presence of God. A minute later, I heard her breathe her last breath, and she transitioned peacefully.

My mother lived a sanctified, Holy Spirit-powered life for 52 years, after her divine encounter with the Lord at age 30. She remained married to my father for 65 years and birthed four children. She died at the age of 82. I am so thankful to have experienced her faithfulness, power, holiness, signs, and wonders firsthand; and I'm eternally grateful for her legacy and God's amazing grace that saved and turned a sinner into a saint of God.

Attention Husbands and Wives: Have you Paid Your Affection Bill?

Most people are familiar with the phone, electric, and gas bills, which are due monthly. However, are you familiar with the "Affection Bill?" I Corinthians 7:3 says, "Let the husband render to his wife the affection due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband."

Interview with Pastore Moussa Toure by Barbara Galloway

In the Winter 2023 issue, we shared the testimony of Pastor Moussa Toure, a former Muslim who had a miraculous encounter with Jesus Christ. It was a powerful story and I encourage you to read it if you haven't. It will bless you.

Well, as remarkable as his testimony was, it's not the end of Pastor Moussa's miracles. I caught up with the Pastor again, this time to interview him about his experience of being taken up to Heaven.

RG: Good evening Pastor Toure, I appreciate you taking time out to share your story with The Remarkable God (RG) magazine. Let's start from the beginning, what happened to you and how did it come about?

Pastor Toure: Ever since my miraculous conversion to Christianity, I've had a desire to see the Lord again. It has waxed even stronger over the years. So much so, I traveled to Israel, to experience first-hand those places where Jesus walked the Earth. Being there, I could envision Him in my mind, praying in the Garden of Gethsemane, walking on the Sea of Galilee, and preaching the Sermon on the Mount over 2,000 years ago. I know we walk with the Lord spiritually, but I greatly desired to experience Him in the natural.

RG: I totally understand. I have visited Israel for the same reason, to witness the places where Jesus physically walked upon the Earth. It was a life-changing trip I feel privileged to have been able to experience. Did the trip satisfy your desire to see Jesus?

Pastor Toure: No, not at all. My mind is always seeking after Him. It's as if nothing can satisfy my strong desire to see Him, to be with Him, and to encounter Him. While I didn't see Him again per se, I had no idea what the Lord had in store for me this time. One day, I was in my house, and I suddenly began feeling like I was being caught up or pulled up toward Heaven.

RG: Were you being caught up in the physical (your entire body) or in the spiritual realm (outside the body)?

Pastor Toure: I am not sure, but I immediately thought of 2 Corinthians 12:7 when Paul said about himself "I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago – whether in the body I do not know, or whether out of the body I do not know, God knows – such a one was caught up to the third heaven." As I was ascending I could see the physical realm, my house, the city, and as I kept ascending, I could see the USA, then the globe, and then the whole world. As I broke through the clouds, everything disappeared

from my view. The force that was pulling me would stop and turn me around so I could see below and then it would begin pulling me up again. I could hear and feel the whirring of air as I was being pulled upward.

RG: Were you afraid? What did you think was happening?

Pastor Toure: I was not afraid because the force was holding me securely by the back of my neck. I felt peaceful, safe, and joyful. The force kept taking me up, up and up, past the clouds, until I entered a realm that didn't look like anything I had ever seen. This realm's atmosphere was nothing like Earth's atmosphere. It was beautiful, shining, and radiant like a ray of light. It was as bright as the sun, but it wasn't the color of the sun. I couldn't stop staring at it and I had a strong urge to touch it, but I just kept gazing at it. The force holding me gave me time to look at it; and then it positioned me to look downward, where I could see beyond the atmosphere, through a window-like opening, a city.

RG: Did the city seem far away? Did you recognize the city?

Pastor Toure: The city was not too far or too close. I could see the most prominent portion of the city, and it came to me it was the new Jerusalem. At that moment, everything in me was totally consumed by the city. I wanted to take in every little detail: the buildings' heights, structures, and the differences between each building. The buildings and the streets were made of gold. It was so pure and clean, that I knew in my spirit if I were to touch anything it would become dirty. I said to myself, in my spirit, "have to stay here!" If the force wasn't holding me, I would have been compelled to just jump or fly down to the city. I decided "I am not going back! There's no way I'm going back! I must figure out how to free myself of this force holding me back." I mustered up all my strength and tried to push myself away from the force, but I couldn't break loose. I tried again and again, but the hand was still holding me. I got discouraged and gave up.

RG: So, you were ready to permanently go down to the city, even if it meant you could never get back to earth and your life?

Pastor Toure: Yes, it was so wonderful, appealing, and attractive to all my being I didn't want to know any place other than this place. But then, after my attempts to break free failed, the force whisked me

off to another place. This time I could see a deep, huge hole much further down. The voice of the force that was holding me said "This is where you send the demons when you cast them out." We then started descending, and I could feel the air whirring past us again. We went through the clouds again and suddenly the globe appeared, then the United States, then I saw my city, and finally my house. I then found myself in my bed.

RG: Pastor Toure, how long were you gone? And do you think you were dreaming?

Pastor Toure: I would estimate it took about 10 minutes. No, no, not at all. It was different from a dream because I was conscious, I was awake. It was more like an open vision. My body was still in bed, but my spirit ascended to Heaven.

RG: How has this experience changed you?

Pastor Toure: This world and whatever it can offer has no appeal or excitement for me anymore. I can no longer rejoice and get excited about things like I did before this encounter. It was so enjoyable to my entire being, not just one part of me. It is now the center of my joy and I am in a constant search for the feeling that seeing that city gave me. It's difficult for me to participate in worldly, social things. People often say to me "You don't seem to be here with us." The picture of the city's beauty, magnificence, and purity is always in my mind and heart. You cannot remove it once you see it and I am always comparing that vision to everything I see in the world. It all falls woefully, painfully short. Every day I read about the new Jerusalem in Revelation to try and absorb every detail of heaven and the new Jerusalem.

RG: Does what you read in Scripture about heaven match what you experienced?

Pastor Toure: Yes, it describes what I saw, especially the atmosphere. There was no physical light because there was no need for light as we know it. When reading Revelation, I am reminded of the purity, the beauty, and the streets paved in gold, which I witnessed.

RG: Throughout the entire experience, did you see Jesus Himself?

Pastor Toure: No, the only personification was the hand that was holding me and the voice that said, "This is where you send the demons when you cast them out."

RG: What have you learned from this experience and what would you want others to know?

Pastor Toure: I am now certain that the Lord will return unexpectedly. As the Word says, "No one knows neither the day nor the hour, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only." I wasn't expecting what happened to me to happen. It was just a normal day. And now, I'm forever changed. I am always waiting and expecting the Lord to come back. We need to be ready, and not be caught unaware like the foolish virgins who had no oil in their lamps.

RG: Thank you for sharing this remarkable story with us Pastor Toure. I am sure it will be as encouraging to readers as it is to me; assuring us that a magnificent and glorious heaven awaits; and that we will want no other place once we lay our eyes on it. If you are finding it hard to manage your finances, you are not alone. 70 percent of Americans live paycheck to paycheck and that was before the pandemic. Conversely, many people are financially secure.

In the largest study of millionaires in America, more than 10,000 people answered questions on how they became millionaires. Here are some takeaways from the survey:

- 1. 79% were first-time millionaires and did not inherit any money.
- 2. 8 out of 10 invested in their company's 401k.
- The top five careers for millionaires are (1) Engineer, (2) Accountant, (3) Teacher, (4) Management, and (5) Lawyer.
- 4. 33% never had a six-figure household income in a single working year and only 31% averaged a \$100,000 household income per year.

The underlying theme here is that the American dream of prosperity is alive and well. However, you must have a plan.

In my experience, over the years of working with more than 600 people, what stands out is a lack of vision - a short-sightedness. We focus on the present without enough thoughts about the future. While all of the following things are important, we have a tendency to do one thing without considering the other:

Clothes over a car; car over an apartment; an apartment over vacation; vacation over children; children over their education; and everything over retirement.

No matter how much money you make, you will not have enough to purchase everything you want. Yes, no matter how much money we make, we all have competing priorities. You will have to compromise, even if your name is Warren Buffett or Elon Musk.

"Where there is no vision, the people perish." Proverbs 29:18a (NIV)

Live within your means with your future in mind. In other words, begin with the end in mind, so that whatever financial decisions you make will not affect your long term goals, like retirement.

Do not behave like Adam and Eve who were blessed with a garden of inexhaustible amounts of delicious food and fruit. They walked past all of it to eat of the forbidden tree in the middle of the garden. They had a scarcity mindset, focusing on what they did not have, instead of having a mindset of gratitude and focusing on all of their many blessings. Remember financial success is a long game.

MENTAL HEALTH TALK: MATTERS OF THE MIND MENTAL HEALTH AND AGING PART 2: THE CURRENT STATE OF DEPRESSION IN OLDER ADULTS

Greetings! I pray that this article finds everyone, everywhere mentally well. Last quarter I discussed depression on the rise for older adults. After talking with many seniors at Church and talking with a sister who has been working with the elderly for thirty years, depression among the elderly, just like suicide in the black communities, are topics that need to be continuously discussed. In the previous article, data showed that an estimated 20% of individuals, age 55 or older, encounter some type of mental health issue. These issues include but are not limited to, "anxiety, severe cognitive impairment, and mood disorders, such as depression or bipolar disorder" (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and National Association of Chronic Disease Disorder, 2008, p. 1). It also disclosed depression as being the most prevalent mental health problem among older adults (p. 2). So, like others, I ask myself, why would an elderly person be depressed? Haven't they lived a full life, retired, and ready to spend time with family or try something different; vacation longer, change career, relocate, and or participate in a sports activity? While writing Part One of this piece, the author also pondered on those same questions. Because of the questions and the dialogue that I had started, it was necessary to continue examining the current state of depression in older adults.



Depression looks different for everyone. In elders, it may be difficult to identify because elderly people may have different symptoms than younger people. For some elders with depression, sadness is not their primary symptom. They could instead be feeling more detachment or have a lack of interest in activities. They may not be as willing to talk about their feelings. Research shows that many older adults are not depressed. Although depression is not a normal part of aging, many elders are at a higher risk of experiencing the disorder. It is a real and curable medical condition. That can be diagnosed and treated just like diabetes and hypertension. Research further stated that "about 80% of older adults have at least one chronic health condition, and 50% have two or more. Depression is



more common in people who also have other illnesses (such as heart disease or cancer) or whose function becomes limited" (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, September 2023, p. 1). It is easy to misdiagnose older adults because doctors may, in oversight, view their symptoms of depression as a natural reaction to sickness or other life changes. Therefore, overlook their depression as a condition that needs to be treated. Older people often have this same ideology because they don't know that they could mentally feel better with appropriate diagnosis and treatment. They too just think it's a part of getting older and their sadness comes from the lack of independence or illness (p. 1).

In conclusion, although a good number of older adults silently suffer from depression, "the good news is that many older adults are not depressed. Approximately one to five percent of older adults living in communities, independently, have Major Depressive Disorder while that number increases to 13.5% for those that require in-home care and to 11.5% for those that are hospitalized" (Seevai and Shah, p. 1). However, it appears that more dialogue needs to take place in terms of mental health wellness among the elderly as well. This topic is so broad that it cannot be discussed in one or two articles. There must be ongoing discussions for the communities, particularly African Americans. According to Taylor and Chatters, (2020), "there is an acute need for improved access to mental health care services in communities of color, a need that has been exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic" (pl. 1). In March 2022, "the White House announced a strategy to address the mental health crisis, including measures to strengthen provider capacity and expand access to services" (1). The health policy leaders are also pursuing,

- policies to expand the workforce of culturally competent mental health care providers, which requires encouraging the next generation of medical students of color to pursue mental health disciplines as well as training current providers in cultural sensitivity,
- targeting mental health services to meet the needs of older adults of color and, in particular, helping them overcome entrenched cultural attitudes associated with seeking mental health care and making sure services are affordable and accessible,
- expansion of free or affordable care, particularly for low-income adults, through increased reimbursement for mental health services in Medicaid, and
- integration of mental health services with primary care, which would improve access and make routine the provision of behavioral health services" (1).

As a Mental Health Provider, I will continue to watch these new changes that will allegedly take place for those in need of mental health services.

Join me for the next article where I will tackle Mental Health and The Black Church. Again, a topic that is rarely, if ever discussed. As an African American Christian woman, a lot of time is spent by my culture at church? I will investigate the role of the Black Church in terms of mental health in the communities. What is the role; do they have one? Since this will be a major piece, it will be discussed in four parts next year. 


