## CRITICAL ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTHCARE

The pressing demand for affordable and quality mental health services within our community and nationwide continues to increase. In 2022, a key development in addressing this need for our patients was the collaboration with psychiatrist Dr. Carlos Diaz, who generously offered to begin seeing Victory patients at no cost. During 2023, he delivered direct care to patients and also worked closely with Victory's medical team, lending his specialized knowledge as needed. This collaboration highlighted the critical role that mental health experts, including therapists, counselors, and psychiatrists, play in our care model, especially in supporting uninsured adults.

## **PROVIDING ACCESS TO SURGERY** *William M. Lightfoot, M.D. Surgical Patient Assistance Fund*



#### During 2023, Victory Health Partners continued

to address the daunting obstacles faced by uninsured patients in obtaining surgical care. These necessary surgeries, often financially out of reach, present a severe burden for individuals, potentially leading to dire health outcomes and emotional distress. The impact extends beyond the patients themselves, touching their families and communities, and in some cases, may even contribute to a decreased lifespan.

The William M. Lightfoot Surgery Fund, established in 2021 to mitigate these challenges, went beyond facilitating surgeries in 2023. It also played a pivotal role in covering essential diagnostic tests and procedures in hospitals, which are vital for detecting serious conditions, including cancer. Despite their high costs, these diagnostics are indispensable for ensuring accurate diagnoses, allowing our medical team to provide timely and effective treatments. Without this critical support, patients' conditions could deteriorate dramatically, underscoring the significance of early and precise diagnosis. The ability to offer these life-changing surgeries was made possible through the unwavering support and collaboration with local hospitals, showcasing the power of community partnerships in extending a lifeline to those in need.

## **EMPOWERING HEALTH AND MOBILITY** *The Impact of Physical Therapy Partnerships*

Victory is committed to bringing hope and healing to our patients, and a crucial part of this mission involves providing access to the life-changing benefits of physical therapy. Our goal was straightforward: alleviate pain, improve mobility, and enable patients to take control of their health.

During 2023, we expanded our partnerships, bringing on board University of South Alabama Physical Therapy Department, Renew Physical Therapy and Wellness, and BenchMark Physical Therapy. The utilization of re-purposed room and donated equipment allowed the establishment of a New Patient Physical Therapy Evaluation Clinic. University of South Alabama Physical Therapy Department, instructors and students, along with therapists from BenchMark Physical Therapy conducted initial evaluations at Victory. Patients then continued their care at well-equipped off-site facilities like BenchMark Physical Therapy, Renew Physical Therapy and Wellness, University of South Alabama Physical Therapy Department, and Encore for comprehensive physical therapy.

This collective effort resulted in over 150 patients receiving quality physical therapy care, showcasing the significant impact of these partnerships and the combined dedication of Victory and our partners to enhancing health and wellness for uninsured adults.

## **MY VICTORY JOURNEY**

During summer of 2023, I started volunteering as a Triage Assistant. My passion for the clinic grew very quickly, and so did my aspirations to serve further. I felt the Lord guiding me to find more ways to serve.

Victory Health Partners treats patients holistically, not just addressing their medical needs in the exam room. The clinic's food pantry is a vital component of this approach. It embodies the principle that good health starts with good nutrition, providing patients with access to nutritious foods that significantly enhance their quality of life.

Realizing the benefits of a Food Drive, I teamed up with Tanner McGee, a South Alabama Football Quarterback, and a fellow Triage Volunteer, to pitch the idea to the South Alabama Athletics Department. The response was overwhelming, with contributions from every sports team. With the help of two trucks from Victory's Board member Chris Tracy with Cadence Bank, student-athletes packed two truckloads and a van with donated food and office supplies.

Micaela graduated with her Masters of Exercise Science from the University of South Alabama in December 2023. After receiving six acceptances to Physician Assistant schools, she is preparing to start the University of Florida Physician Assistant Studies. Micaela's story not only reflects her personal growth and dedication to healthcare but also serves as an inspiration for the importance of compassion and action in serving **others**. Volunteering at Victory helped me understand that being a healthcare provider goes beyond diagnoses and treatments; it's about compassion, understanding, and holistic support.
