Testimony by Victory Patient Pastor Stephen Williams



YEAR END GIVING

Ways to Wise Charitable Gifting

Charitable giving comes from your heart but thoughtful ways to make the gift should be done also to fulfill family philanthropic purposes. Tax consequences and liquidity needs of donors should be considered. Let's address cash and appreciated securities briefly.

1. Gifts of Cash This is the easiest way to contribute to charity. A cash gift can be for a specific purpose or as an undesignated contribution. Your out of pocket gift of \$1000 can be less after tax deductions applicable. For example, a donor making a donation of \$1,000 who is in the 24% tax bracket and takes and receives a charitable donation has a net \$760 gift cost. If a person has an IRA and is over 70 1/2 years old, they can make a direct gift from the IRA to charity that counts toward their required minimum contributions that begin at age 72. The gift is excluded from gross income resulting in a tax saving similar in amount to the prior example and this may be easier than assuring full use of the income tax charitable deduction. Such IRA gifts are limited to \$100,000 in any one year.

2. Appreciated Securities Gifts One of the alternatives to a cash donation is the gift of appreciated securities. A gift of appreciated securities held for over a year has greater tax benefits in that you receive a deduction for the full fair market value of the securities and avoid the taxation of the capital gain that would have been realized on a sale. As an example, you gift \$10,000 in stock with a cost basis of \$1,000 receiving a charitable deduction of \$10,000 and avoiding \$9,000 in capital gains tax. The \$10000 charitable deduction to the extent itemized and allowed reduces your income tax causing the gift cost to be further reduced similar to a cash gift.


