

Muanivatu Trails Experience Child Protection Code of Conduct

1. Respect and Dignity:

- I will treat all children with respect, dignity, and kindness, regardless of their race, ethnicity, gender, religion, disability, or any other status.
- I will value and celebrate the diversity of children's backgrounds and experiences.

2. Child's Best Interests:

- I will always prioritize the best interests of the child in every action and decision.
- I will take all reasonable steps to ensure the child's safety, well-being, and emotional health.

3. Non-Discrimination:

- I will not discriminate against any child based on their personal characteristics.
- I will promote an inclusive environment where all children feel valued and welcomed.

4. Appropriate Physical Contact:
