TERMS FOR CLIMBERS



Read the participation conditions carefully, sign and hand them over to the park staff. Young people under the age of 18 must have a guardian's approval and signature to participate. Always ask the staff if something feels unclear.

- You must undergo a safety briefing and follow all rules that TreeWalker's instructor gives you.
- You must not be under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.
- You must not smoke with the climbing harness on.
- We do not recommend that you participate if you are pregnant, have neck or back problems.
- You must not weigh more than 120kg.
- Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult climber.
- As an adult climber, you may be responsible for a maximum of three children.
- You have full responsibility for you/your minor's activity and safety during the stay.
- You may use the toilet without a harness.
- Harness and helmet must be returned to staff, and may not be removed and left in the park.
- Handle the equipment with care, if you deliberately destroy it or are careless you will be liable for compensation.
- Tie up long hair and put away loose objects before climbing.
