

Covid 19 Policy

The safety of your child is paramount, more so during the times that we are experiencing currently, and the safety and wellness of those people who your child is in contact with is also extremely important. With this in mind I have taken the time to create this Policy to ensure that when I care for your child it is done so in the safest way for us all.

All children MUST be well and showing NO symptoms. I am requesting that you do not give your child Calpol or similar for any reason prior to them attending. If you feel that your child cannot manage the day without Calpol, in the current climate and to ensure the safety for everyone your child may come in contact with, I need to ask that they stay with their parent/carer. The reason is because Calpol can mask a temperature .

As a reminder the first common symptoms of COVID-19 are;

a high temperature of 37.8 and above

a new, continuous cough.

If your child develops any symptoms of being unwell within our care, I will contact parents or the emergency contact and the child will need to be collected immediately - alongside of this request; emergency contacts will be need to be updated if there are any changes of these.

Please be aware you will still be charged for our service.

If your child has any symptoms please follow the government guidelines as these do change and are updated frequently.

If any of our staff has a cough or fever as outlined, we will ensure a replacement is ready for you. If we need to cancel the booking due to covid we will have completed a PCR test and contact you immediately.

Kim's creche will ensure we follow the correct procedures to reduce the risk of cross infection, but my initial role to provide care is still the most important. I just want to make a point that I plan to focus on making the children enjoy their time here and take their attention away from these scary times. If we all follow the rules, we can and will stay safe.

Again if your child is poorly in anyway please provide a negative test result to a member of our staff with your child's name on. I understand there are only a few symptoms on the gov website however i want to ensure i safeguard children and staff attending and can only do this by being strict.

We all have to work together to ensure we are all as safe and at the lowest of risk possible.
