

4. Vehicle Roadworthiness

- Ensure that all vehicles remain in a roadworthy condition. (a)
- Maintain and implement policies and procedures for pre-trip inspections.
- Take corrective roadworthy action immediately.
- Perform regular and preventative maintenance and servicing of vehicles and equipment. (d)

5. Loads

- Ensure all loads are safe and secure. (a)
- Ensure all loads do not exceed the maximum permissible axle and vehicle load masses. (b)
- Ensure special loads carry the necessary permits / documentation.

6. Operating Efficiency

Strive to maintain high standards of operational efficiency through the optimal (a) use of resources, cost reductions and fuel efficiencies.

- Comply with the highest levels of safety and best practices relating to cargo transported. (a)
- Comply with all compulsory relevant SANS standards. (b)
- Ensure that all reflective material and lamps are in working condition. (c)
- Improve methods of spray and dust reduction to allow safer passing by other vehicles. (d)
- (e) Develop programmes to progressively meet safety standards (SANS1395 / ISO39001).

10. Commitment to the Association
