MESSAGES FROM YOUNG LEADERS

- Care for me, yet also challenge me to be my best.
- Let's follow and learn from the industries who are taking the lead, for example, the South African Wine Industry
- The top three challenges leaders face today are:
 - Retaining talent
 - Developing the next generation of leaders
 - Maintaining an engaged workforce









MESSAGES FROM YOUNG LEADERS

- The future leader is a leader who:
 - Leads authentically
 - Is able to build trust
 - Is values based and can balance and align personal and organisational values
 - Is a personal and human centered leader in an increasingly high tech environment
 - · Has mastered the art of listening and engaging
 - Enables people to find purpose in their work
 - Is hungry to continuously be better versions of themselves
- We can no longer afford the luxury of "old school" leadership.
