During the month of October we love to immerse all areas of the classroom with fall-themed activities. The children will be exploring the different parts of leaves and trees through hands-on projects, such as identifying, coloring and labeling their parts, leaf rubbing. We will also focus on observing the season, and all of the fascinating

changes that come with it.

The new students are finishing their first map of the world. The class learned our planet is made of land, air, and water. This led to learning the names of continents. We had fun learning the different parts of the leaf and flower.

Another area that we will be exploring is the Solar System. This is always a wonderful time in our classrooms as the children are very excited to learn about our planets, using our planet models and singing our planet song.
