Extended Day Updates



After a month of practicing quantity counting and number recognition, we will now focus on odd and even numbers. Using concrete math manipulatives will we be able to show how all even numbers have a partner and odd numbers don't. Identifying even and odd numbers is an important skill that helps children understand our number system and provides them aids in their preparation for whole number operations.







Science Discoveries

In the last month, we have been learning about the different properties of animals, whether they are nocturnal or diurnal, whether they are vertebrates or invertebrates . This month, we will continue learning about our amazing animal kingdom and the different animal species.



This month we will be exploring the artistic methods of Pablo Picasso. His specialization in cubism art, showing multiple angles of one object simultaneously, will be focused on in our projects for December.



During the month of December, we will be learning about more letters and the sounds they make. We will be doing fun holiday crafts related to the season to make letter sound recognition even more fun!
