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
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
Tidbits From The Teachers

We are looking forward to a busy spring! There will be many new learning experiences for the children.

Our main focus this month will be the lifecycle of the chicken and embryology as well as the lifecycle of the butterfly. These are two of our most exciting topics in the eyes of the children. There is so much for the students to discover within these units. We will work on daily activities to learn about the incubation process, and by the time the chicks hatch, all of the children will have such great knowledge about this fascinating event. 
Science Discoveries


