#### **Nursery build**

#### Headlice in school

Last term we seemed to have an influx of headlice cases within school, with many children being treated and then catching them again after a short period.

With this in mind we are asking you to be extra vigilant. We advise for children with long hair to have their hair tied up/back and ask parents to check their own child's hair regularly. If a case is discovered in school we will speak directly to the parents ensuring that you follow up with treatment. Advice suggests that any child treated need to be treated again on day 7 and then possibly again on day 14 if the issue is not eradicated.

## Kidsafe


Our Kidsafe sessions with Mrs Watts will be starting this term. These sessions will begin with Year 5/6 before going through school to Year 1 by the summer term.


# TT Rockstars
