

Senator Monica Martinez Announces \$25 Million in Capital Funding for NYS Volunteer Fire Departments

I'm proud to announce the launch of the Volunteer Fire Infrastructure Grant Program, which will provide \$25 million in capital funding for NYS volunteer fire departments to support upgrades and improvements to fire stations, training facilities, and equipment supplies.

Funding for this program, in addition to \$10 million included in the 2023-2024 budget for stipends to aid in the recruitment and retention of these volunteers. These funds will help offset the ongoing fiscal challenges posed to volunteer fire departments while also supporting increased services to communities across New York State.

The New York State Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES) is accepting applications for V-FIRE funding until April 30, 2024. Funds will be awarded competitively to eligible organizations that are located within and serve New York State.



\$1.9 Million Grant Approved to Repair North Babylon Dam

Supervisor Rich Schaffer is pleased to announce the approval of a New York Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) grant to repair the dam, culverts and flood gate at the Elda Lake Dam in North Babylon.

This \$1,959,938 grant is through the NYSDOT Bridge Grant Program. The consulting firm NV5 of Melville, NY was instrumental in securing the grant as well as the Town of Babylon Department of Environmental Control. The project is shovel ready with all New York State Department of Environmental Conservation permits in place.

"This is a very important project to address failing culverts that threatens an important Town road (Phelps Lane) that provides access to residences, Town offices and several schools," Schaffer said. "The repair is also important to help address downstream flooding of the Carll's River Watershed during intense precipitation events."




