Section 1. Subsections (1) and (3) of section 7.04 and sections 7.05 and 7.08 of Article VII of chapter 12760, Laws of Florida (1927), as amended by chapter 2017-200, Laws of Florida, are amended to read:

7.04 Authority members.-

(1) There shall be five members of the authority appointed by the Governor a majority vote of the city commission. The members shall be diverse and representative of the community.

business judgment, as identified by the <u>Governor</u> city commission, who is expected to perform his or her official duties in the best interests of GRU and its customers. Appointments shall be made as follows:

- (a) One member shall be a residential customer with substantial knowledge of GRU, its operations, and its history.
- (b) At least one member shall be a private, nongovernment customer consuming at least 10,000 kilowatt hours per month of electric usage during each of the previous 12 months. If the customer is an entity, this member may be the owner or representative of such customer.
- (c) Three members shall be competent and knowledgeable in one or more specific fields substantially related to the duties and functions of the authority, including, but not limited to, law, economics, accounting, engineering, finance, or energy.
- upon expiration of any member's term, or upon any authority vacancy, to reflect the ratio of total electric meters serving GRU electric customers outside the city's jurisdictional boundaries to total electric meters serving all GRU electric customers. For example, upon expiration of a member's term or upon an authority vacancy, if the ratio of total electric meters serving customers outside the city boundaries to total electric meters serving customers outside the city boundaries to total electric meters serving all electric customers reaches 40 percent, the Governor city commission must appoint a second member from

outside the city boundaries to serve the next term that would otherwise be served by a qualified elector of the city. Conversely, upon expiration of any member's term or upon any authority vacancy, if the ratio subsequently falls below 40 percent, the <u>Governor city commission</u> must appoint a qualified elector of the city to serve the next term that otherwise would have been served by a resident from outside the city boundaries.

- 7.05 Member nominations and terms.
- (1) The <u>Governor city commission</u> shall issue a public notice soliciting citizen nominations for authority members within 120 days after the approval at referendum of the creation of this article. The nomination solicitation period shall remain open for at least 30 days after the date of the public notice.
- members to the authority from among the nominees within 60 days after the close of the nomination solicitation period. The initial terms of office for the five members shall commence at 12 a.m. on October 1, 2023 2019. The terms of the initial appointments shall be as follows: one member shall be designated to serve until 12 a.m. October 1, 2024 2020; one member shall be designated to serve until 12 a.m. October 1, 2025 2021; one member shall be designated to serve until 12 a.m. October 1, 2025 2021; one member shall be designated to serve until 12 a.m. October 1, 2026 2022; and two members shall be designated to serve until 12 a.m. October 1, 2026 2022; and two members shall be designated to serve until 12 a.m. October 1, 2027 2023.

- (3) The <u>Governor</u> <u>city commission</u> shall have a citizen nomination solicitation period for at least 30 days and appoint members for subsequent terms from among the nominees. Members appointed for subsequent terms shall be appointed for 4-year terms commencing at 12 a.m. on October 1 of the year in which they are appointed. If a member is appointed to complete an unexpired term, the member's term shall commence at the time of appointment and shall continue through the remainder of the unexpired term.
- (4) The <u>Governor city commission</u> shall fill any vacancy for the unexpired portion of a term within 60 days after the vacancy occurs if the remainder of the term exceeds 90 days.
 - 7.08 Removal and suspension of members.
- (1) A member may be removed or suspended from office by the <u>Governor city commission</u> in accordance with s. 112.501, Florida Statutes. In addition to the grounds for removal set forth therein, a member may be removed by the <u>Governor city commission</u> for failure to maintain the qualifications specified in section 7.04.
- (2) The authority may recommend to the <u>Governor city</u> commission that a member be removed or suspended from office if it finds, by vote of at least three members, a reasonable basis for removal or suspension on one or more of the grounds set forth in s. 112.501, Florida Statutes, or for failure to maintain the qualifications specified in section 7.04. The

authority shall give reasonable notice of any proceeding in which such action is proposed and must provide the member against whom such action is proposed a written statement of the basis for the proposed action and an opportunity to be heard. The member against whom such action is proposed may not participate in the authority's debate or vote on the matter.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
