WHY COLOMBIA?

had an unexpected opportunity to go to Colombia in November of 2018 with three friends from Vision Baptist Church. While there, I learned that God was doing something great in South America. God placed such a heavy burden on me when Miguel Sanabria (Missionary in Medellin, Colombia) took my friends and I to a school where the children bowed down to

a statue of a woman who had died centuries before, praying to her in unison. Their teachers told the children that they had to be good, and listen to their eyes to the fact that Colombia is in a desperate need of Christ.

OUR BURDEN

After I witnessed what the people were being taught and what they were teaching their children, how could that not affect my heart?

I realized something more though. I realized that God is preparing Latin America for the Gospel to come in and save those who are lost! There are scores of people there who are seeking the real truth of God's Word. There are people who desperately want God to work in their lives. But there are so few of God's people who are taking

OUR FIRST TERM

aving been able to know, love, and serve under several different pastors, there were always concerns with young and new missionaries. I remember talking to some of my pastors about a concern they have about missionaries not making it to the field, or missionaries getting discouraged and leaving the field. Those are genuine concerns, and ones that I have taken closely to heart.

During our first two years on the field, we plan on working with a veteran missionary who has lived there, and knows the culture. We will be in language school, we will learn the Colombian culture, and will work in Miguel's and Mariangela's ministry in Medellin, Colombia.



We are very excited about that opportunity! We hope to work hard and be a great blessing to them while we are there.

The benefits that we will have working in their ministry are:

- A constant friend and mentor
- Encouragement with culture shock and difficulties
- ministry, language, and culture experience

Bridgette and I want you to know that we know God has called us into the ministry, that we will seek Christ, and work hard to see souls saved, trained, and baptized, and churches planted across Colombia, South America. We have every intention of staying on the field for the rest of our lives, and will hold ourselves accountable to God and others.

COLOMBIAN STATISTICS

- There are more church within 5 hours of Alpharetta, Ga than there are Bible-believing churches in all of Colombia.
- 95% of Colombians are Catholic, while the remaining 5% make up several religious groups including Islam, Buddhist, Sikhs, Jehovah's Witnesses, Mormon, Church of God, Pentecostal, etc.
- Christians (like us) make up .02% of Colombia.
- There are over 51 million people in Colombia.
- Colombia is made up of 32 states.
- Bogata, the capital, has a population of 7.5 million people. Medellin, the second largest city, has 3.5 million people.

GOD

We believe in the Trinity, the unity of the Godhead. There are three persons: The FATHER, The SON, and The HOLY SPIRIT. They are equally perfect in every divine quality, and execute distinct but harmonious offices in the great work of redemption. (A) We believe in GOD the FATHER (B) We believe in JESUS CHRIST (C) We believe in the HOLY SPIRIT. Genesis 1:1,26; John 1:1,3; Matthew 28:19; John 4:24; Romans 1:19,20; Ephesians 4:5,6

THE FATHER

We believe in God the Father, an infinite, personal spirit, perfect in holiness, wisdom, power and love. We believe that He infallibly foreknows all that shall come to pass, that He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of men, that He hears and answers prayer, and that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ. We believe in Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son, conceived by the Holy Spirit. We believe Jesus Christ is God. We believe in His virgin birth, sinless life, miracles, and teachings. We believe in His substitutionary atoning death, bodily resurrection, ascension into heaven, perpetual intercession for His people, and personal visible return to earth. THE HOLY SPIRIT

We believe in the person of the Holy Spirit who came forth from the Father and Son to convict the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment, and to regenerate, sanctify, and empower all who believe in Jesus Christ. We believe that the Holy Spirit indwells every believer in Christ, and that He is an abiding helper, teacher and guide. John 14: 16, 17,26; 15:26,27; John 16:9-14; Romans 8:9; I Corinthians 3:16; 6:19; Galatians 5:22-26



MAN

We believe that all men by nature, choice and practice are sinners, but that "God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." We believe, therefore, that those who repent of their sins and by faith receive Christ as Lord and Savior will rejoice forever in God's presence, and those who refuse to receive Christ as Lord and Savior will be forever separated from God. ETERNAL STATE

We believe in a literal Heaven, the eternal home of the redeemed. We believe Heaven to be the literal place where the saved will live forever in the eternal bliss and blessings of God. We believe in Hell, the Christ-less eternity for the lost, where there will be burning and tormenting for those without salvation, who have refused to receive the gospel and Jesus Christ as Lord. We believe that Hell, unbelievers, Satan and all the fallen angels shall be cast into the lake of fire to be tormented day and night forever and forever. SALVATION

We believe salvation involves the redemption of the whole man, and is offered freely to all who accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, who by His own blood obtained eternal redemption for the believer. In its broadest sense salvation includes regeneration, justification, sanctification, and glorification. There is no salvation apart from personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord. BAPTISM

We believe in baptism by immersion after salvation with no merit for salvation in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost (Spirit). We reject infant baptism and any form of sprinkling for infants or adults. Baptism is an outward expression of our faith in Jesus Christ and simply a public testimony of what God has done by His grace. Romans 6: 1-5; Acts 8:36-38; Acts 2;41; Matthew 3:16; Matthew 28:19-20.24; John 14:2; 2 Corinthians 5:8; Revelation 21-22

THE CHURCH

We believe in the local church, consisting of a company of professing, born-again believers in Jesus Christ, immersed on a credible confession of faith, and associated for worship, work and fellowship. We believe that to those local churches we are committed, for per petual observance of the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper, that

that God has laid upon these churches the task of proclaiming to a lost world the acceptance of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and the enthroning of Him as Lord and Master. Its scriptural officers are pastors and deacons. While both men and women are gifted for service in the church, the office of pastor is limited to men as qualified by Scripture. Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Acts 2:42; Romans 6:3-5; I Corinthians 11:23-26; Ephesians 2:19-22; Ephesians 5:19-21; 1 Timothy 2:9-14; 3:1-15; 4: 14; Hebrews 10:23-25.

THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN CHURCH AND STATE

We believe that every human being is responsible to God alone in all matters of faith; that each church is independent and autonomous and must be free from any ecclesiastical or political authority; therefore, Church and State must be kept separate as having different functions with each fulfilling its duties free from the dictation or patronage of the other. Matthew 22:21; Mark 12:17; Luke 20:25; Acts 5:29; I Timothy 2:5; Romans 13:1-7; 14:7-9,12

SPIRITUAL GIFTS

We believe that spiritual gifts are given to the church for the express purpose of winning the lost and edifying other believers. The Holy Spirit is given to each believer upon acceptance of Christ and His purpose is to exalt and bring people to Christ. Speaking in tongues was the least important of these gifts and was given as a sign for unbelieving Jews. That is why Vision Baptist Church does not teach or practice speaking in tongues. John 7:37-39; 14: 17; Acts 2:38; 1 Corinthians 1:22; 3:16-17; 6:19-20; 12-14

ETERNAL SECURITY

We believe in the eternal security of all blood-bought individuals or believers and that such inheritance is incorruptible, and undefiled, and that each believer is kept by the power of God and nothing can separate us from Him, ourselves included. We believe that believers can lose the joy of fellowship

with God, can grieve God and can quench the Spirit of God in him or her, but not lose his/her salvation. John 3:16; 5:24; 6:37-39; 10:27-30; Romans 8: 35-39; Philippians 1 :6; Titus 1 :2; 1 Peter 1 :5; 1 John 5: 11-13; Jude 24

WORLD EVANGELISM

We believe that the apostolic office ceased with the death of the Apostles. We believe that it is His church that He promised continual existence, to continue the work He started until He comes again. We believe that the ministry of reconciliation is committed to every believer and all are saints/priests of God. The Lord Jesus Christ has commanded the preaching of the gospel to all nations. It is the duty and privilege of every follower of Christ and of every church of the Lord Jesus Christ to endeavor to make disciples of all nations. Matthew 16: 18; 28: 18-20; Mark 16: 15; John 20:21; Acts 1:8; 2 Corinthians 5: 18-21; 1 Peter 2:9; Revelation 1:6; 5:10
