Want to participate?

- Bring around 5 items to be scanned (no more than 10) between 10 a.m. and noon.
 - Material should be flat and smaller than 8.5x11 inches so they fit on the scanner.
 - These items can be old, but they don't have to be! The recent past will be history soon, so let's preserve it now!
- Share the stories behind these items (photos, letters, fliers, etc.) and get them scanned.
- Stay for the feed!
