• Patient Advocate-

A dedicated staff member will help you navigate any and all assistance programs you may be eligible for. Do you need help navigating your insurance options? Do you need food or housing assistance? Do you need help finding out how to enroll in your tribe? Our staff can help guide you through the complications that come with a lot of programs and set you on the right course for getting the tools you need.

• Diabetes Education-

A diabetes coordinator will meet with you to discuss your treatment plan, healthy lifestyle choices, and give you the tools and support you need. We are also a Special Diabetes for Indians (SDPI) Community-Directed Grant site. This program was established because of the disproportionate percentage of American Indians and Alaska Natives that have diabetes compared with other groups.
