## FROM THE PASTOR:

God has a plan for how His church is to be organized and function. It's not about bureaucracies or rules or power or human control; it's all about humility, servanthood and joyful contribution.

Paul discussed it to the church in Corinth: "Now about the gifts of the Spirit, brothers and sisters, I do not want you to be uninformed... ... Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good." (1 Cor. 12:1, 7)

In other words, God gives to people who follow Jesus spiritual gifts (God-powered, God-chosen abilities) for you to build up the church and serve other people in ways that will bring fulfillment to you, and goodness and growth to people.

Paul referred to the church as the human body: "Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it." (1 Cor. 12:27)

God has given every single one of you more than one spiritual gifts, and He wants you to use it to serve the church and do your part in Christ's body. That means, without YOU practicing your spiritual gift, the church body doesn't function in the way that it's supposed to do.

Since it is important that everybody who is part of the church identifies and serves with their spiritual gifts, I'm going to launch a two-part sermon series with Spiritual Gifts after Easter.

Everybody who is in Christ has spiritual gifts. And everybody has been invited to serve. If you're not finding a way to serve in the body of Christ, but you're a follower of Jesus, you're missing a deep part of God's calling on your life, and the body is missing out on one of its significant members.

Friends, you are part of the body of Christ. And you matter.
