Dr. Mocumbi is Associate Professor and head of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Eduardo Mondlane University (UEM) in Maputo, Mozambique. He is also the residency Director in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Maputo Central Hospital.

His PhD thesis included community- and hospital-based research, looking at the quality of provision of childbirth care, particularly addressing obstetric fistula as a chronic complication. His research focus is on quality of care within referral hospitals and primary care facilities, particularly looking at poor outcomes such as chronic complications and mortality. He is currently leading efforts to expand the reach of collaborative projects between UEM and International partners to improve patient care, improve the learning environment, and promote research in his department.
