CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAM

In contemporary times, Cancer is not perceived merely as a deadly disease but also seems to unrest the physical, mental, and economical life of society.

Society is lacking all the concerned information and knowledge about the deadly disease. The Tare Zameen foundation has joined hands with Hindustan Petroleum to disseminate proper effective awareness assistance to the masses. The individual fights got the umbrella of the organization so that a public social war could be waged against the deadly cancer disease.

The organization has well understood the fact that this disease must be dealt with at the precautionary level. The scenario of various sections of India, that do not have deep pockets to stand against the high-cost treatment needs to be tackled before time.

Tare Zameen foundation has organized HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAM (CANCER), #Jeet Hamari-1 on 23rd Feb 2019 at IIMC, New JNU Campus Delhi with so many dignitaries personalities like Sri Sanjeeb Patjoshi-IPS Joint Secretary Minister of Panchayati Raj, Sister B.K Silpa (Brahma Kumari), Dr. Chandramani Brahm Dutt (Chairperson of Narayani Sahitya academy), Dr. B.K Behera (CMO-NTPC), Dr. Pawan Gupta (Max Group of Hospital), also many Organization of Delhi NCR has participated in this program. A discussion related to the awareness about cancer diagnosis, investigation, treatment, alternative medicine & prevention was carried out. A total of 5001 were donated to the CRPF welfare association and 450 people were the beneficiaries of this program.

TARGETED BENEFICIARIES

Youngsters, women and adults from the middle and lower classes were sought to be the beneficiaries of this program. Around 450 beneficiaries are successfully covered under this.

TARGETED AREAS

As the venue of the program was chosen as IIMC, new JNU campus. So local as well as visitors from diverse areas also got attached with this program.

- Create awareness among the different shades of cancer prevalent with age and habits of the persons.
- More detailed medicinal assistance to the masses regarding the diagnoses, treatment and reach to the best possible cancer treatment centers.
- Creating a conspicuous mindset against cancer causing susceptible elements like tobacco etc.

WORKSHOP FOR SOCIAL ISSUES USE OF PLASTIC & SUICIDE PREVENTION

Humans are the fortunate living beings on this planet. So with superiority comes responsibility and the ability to preserve, balance, change and advance the natural order through artificial or other strategic means. However, these artificial and anthropogenic expeditions in the search for convenience have also impacted the natural order in negative notes.

This could be well emphasized with the contemporary challenges faced in terms of pollution, global warming, desertification, soil erosion, receding of fresh water, and so on.

In addition to all these degradations, anthropogenic activities also hamper the life of other animals and thus disturb the balanced harmony of the natural system.

Plastic is a huge concern in polluting the contemporary scenario which not only risks the lives of innocent animals but also has caused the shrinkage of land resources.

Being a non-decomposable substance, it has been raising the prolonged questions before the environment conservation body and thus securing prime focus to every Government policy regarding its use and management.

Suicide is an emerging and serious public health issue in India as referred by WHO.

About 8,00,000 people commit suicide worldwide every year. 1,39,123 Indians committed suicide in 2019 and the nation's suicide rate was 10.4 {calculated per lakh of population}.

The reason for this may lie in dealing with alarming pressure in critically challenging times, be it economic, academic, personal and emotional.

In this regards, Tare Zameen Foundation has also joined this global movement against this non-decomposable plastic and thus launch a workshop on the topic

"Workshop for Social issues use of plastic & Suicide Prevention"

The Adhakari team of Daulat Ram college in Delhi collaborated with

the Tare Zameen Foundation and had conducted workshops in the Shanti colony. 

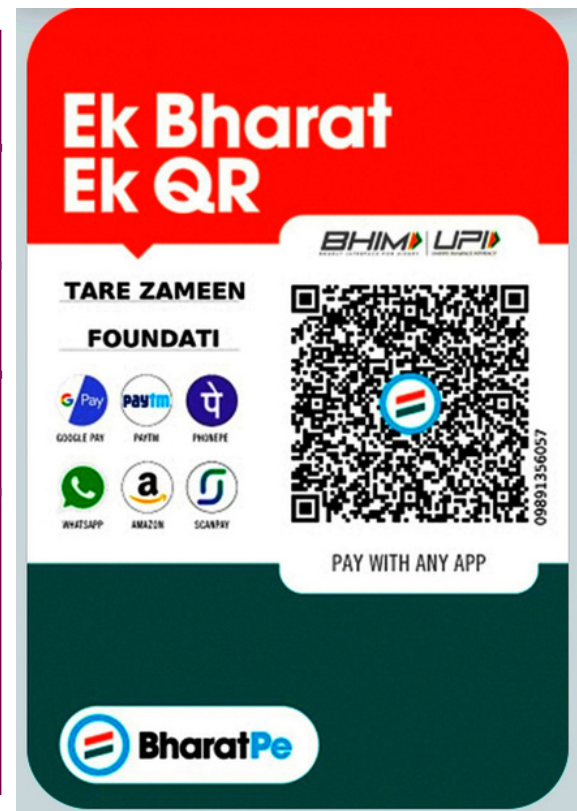
