New Dimension to Scrip Gift Card !

The gift card program allows you to purchase gift cards for hundreds of retailers, local and nationwide. These retailers then kickback 1-15 percent of each card purchased. A variety of cards are available here in the office while many more can be ordered. As each order has a shipping charge, we try to combine as many orders as possible when we order, therefore, it helps us if you plan ahead and not wait until the last minute. You can also purchase cards immediately through the scrip app. If you need a refresher on how to set up the app, contact the school office. Now would be the perfect time to get the app set up so you can begin using for your Christmas shopping.
