

Blujet Basketball Eligibility Guide and Individual Responsibilities

Being a participating member of the Blujet team is a privilege earned through hard work and diligence in school. To fully participate, students must complete assignments on time, maintain a C- average in all subject areas, and remain detention-free. Below are specific examples of ineligibility and the resulting consequences. Refer to the Blujet Handbook for more information and repeated infractions.

Late Assignments & Ineligibility

- An assignment is considered late if it is not turned in on the due date, or if it is turned in incomplete
- 3 late assignments (or 1 assignment more than 3 days late) result in loss of next scheduled game.
- 5 late assignments result in loss of next scheduled game (or tournament) and future games until school work is complete.

Below C- Coursework & Ineligibility

- If average coursework of all subjects drops below a C- during the season, the result is nonparticipation in the program until coursework improves

Detention & Ineligibility

- Any student receiving a detention, in addition to school policy consequences, will also experience the loss of the next scheduled game.

***Important:** When a student is deemed ineligible for a game or games for any of the above reasons, that student is still expected to attend the game, sitting with the team without dressing, and cheering teammates on. Failure to attend the game may result in additional ineligibility of future games.*

Teacher responsibilities: Teachers will report eligibility/ineligibility status to student, parent and principal.

Principal responsibilities: Principal will report eligibility/ineligibility status to coaches.

Coach's responsibilities: Coaches will ensure consequences as listed above are carried out during games and report any student absence to principal.
