# **Quick Silver Swimming Academy Privacy Policy**

This Privacy Policy describes how your personal information is collected, used, and shared when you visit or make a purchase from <a href="https://quicksilverswimming.co.za/">https://quicksilverswimming.co.za/</a> ("the Site")

Quick Silver Swimming Academy, ("the Company", "us", "we", or "our"), operates the website <a href="www.quicksilverswimming.co.za">www.quicksilverswimming.co.za</a>. We may change or add to this privacy notice, so we encourage you to come back and read it periodically. Quick Silver Swimming Academy is the data controller that resides in Cape Town, South Africa.

This privacy notice governs <u>www.quicksilverswimming.co.za</u> and Quick Silver Swimming Academy informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of personal data when you use our Service and the choices you have associated with that data. Your privacy is very important to us.

We use your data to provide and improve our site. By using the site, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

### PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

When you visit the Site, we automatically collect certain information about your device, including information about your web browser, IP address, time zone, and some of the cookies that are installed on your device. Additionally, as you browse the Site, we collect information about the individual web pages or products that you view, what websites or search terms referred you to the Site, and information about how you interact with the Site. We refer to this automatically-collected information as "Device Information."

We collect Device Information using the following technologies:

- "Cookies" are data files that are placed on your device or computer and often include an anonymous unique identifier. For more information about cookies, and how to disable cookies, visit http://www.allaboutcookies.org.
- "Log files" track actions occurring on the Site, and collect data including your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, referring/exit pages, and date/time stamps.
- "Web beacons," "tags," and "pixels" are electronic files used to record information about how you browse the Site.

Additionally when you make a purchase or attempt to make a purchase through the Site, we collect certain information from you, including your name, billing address, shipping address, payment information (including credit card numbers), email address, and phone number. We refer to this information as "Order Information."

When we talk about "Personal Information" in this Privacy Policy, we are talking both about Device Information and Order Information.

### **HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION**

We may use information that we collect about you to:

- 1. Provide information about our Products and Services. We will use your information to provide our products and services to you.
- 2. To fulfill any orders placed through the Site (including processing your payment information, arranging for shipping, and providing you with invoices and/or order confirmations).
- 3. Understand and improve our products. We will perform research and analysis about your use of, or interest in, our products, services, or content, or products, services or content offered by others. We do this to help make our products better and to develop new products.
- 4. Communicate with you. We may send you emails about new product features or other news about us and our business or on topics we think would be relevant to you.
- 5. Responding to your requests. We will also use your information to respond to your questions or comments.
- 6. We may contact you to inform you about changes in our services, our service offering and other important service related notices such as changes to the privacy policy or about security or fraud notices.
- 7. We may develop and display content and advertising tailored to your interests on our products and services on our site and on other sites;

- 8. We also may use your information to manage our business or perform functions as otherwise described to you at the time of collection.
- 9. We use the Device Information that we collect to help us screen for potential risk and fraud (in particular, your IP address), and more generally to improve and optimize our Site (for example, by generating analytics about how our customers browse and interact with the Site, and to assess the success of our marketing and advertising campaigns).

#### **SHARING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION**

We share your Personal Information with third parties to help us use your Personal Information, as described above. For example we use Google Analytics to help us understand how our customers use the Site--you can read more about how Google uses your Personal Information here: https://www.google.com/intl/en/policies/privacy/. Finally, we may also share your Personal Information to comply with applicable laws and regulations, to respond to a subpoena, search warrant or other lawful request for information we receive, or to otherwise protect our rights.

### **BEHAVIOURAL ADVERTISING**

As described above, we use your Personal Information to provide you with targeted advertisements or marketing communications we believe may be of interest to you.
