We are proud of our commitment to improve end-of-life care for Veterans and their families.

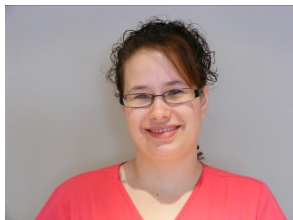

Music Therapy is a rewarding addition to our organization that benefits both patients and their families. Kenna recently displayed her therapeutic techniques at the annual Celebration of Life.

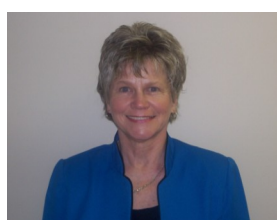
