



March 30, 2022 Session Meeting Highlights

The following are the highlights from the March 30, 2022 Session meeting:

- Session discussed their observations concerning the letters that members sent to Session following the 2022 Annual Meeting.
- The February 2022 financials showed about a \$60,000 surplus. This is an improvement from our financial position at the end of January thanks to increased member pledge payments and expenditures running a bit below budget
- Session approved the proposal for the fabrication and installation of two laminated covered replacement countertops in the kitchen (one 19'- 9" and one 18'-0").
- The Worship Task Force is taking a break as the congregation works through the Lombard process. Session approved pausing:

- Doing anything with the pews and keep them stored
- Moving the early service to Fellowship Hall

Session also approved reconstitution of the Worship Team as a Session team to assist with the logistics for worship services. The Worship Team will create and implement the following:

- Greeter teams.
 - One or two coordinators - one for each service to handle the housekeeping activities related to what we do in each service (they will not be worship directors)
 - Communion coordinators (or a team) which will create a plan for serving communion
 - Tech crew coordinator
 - Creative Worship Planning Team to assist the pastoral staff in planning monthly worship service themes and content.
 - Organize plans for seasonal decorations including plants and flowers.
 - Recommend plan/timeline for possible tech enhancements in both Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall
- The Lombard Steering Team (Bruce Gunn, Anne Ferrera, Deb Palmer) evaluated names submitted to them by Session members for potential individual interviewees for the Lombard process. They focused on identifying a group of members that could provide Lombard with a basic understanding as to who FPCA has been. This will help provide Lombard with a framework for their process and better enable Lombard to understand member comments and concerns. Session approved the following members as the interviewees:
