## In a snapshot, here is what DIG Refresh will look like.

Participants, known as the DIG Refresh Crew, will begin each Sunday following worship. Shepherds will be located in the Sanctuary ready to welcome your child(ren) by grade level. Look for your child's grade level sign.

Then they will head off to one of three age group specific locations. There, Shepherds and children will participate in an opening ritual, learn about a faith practice, and find it in the Bible. Then each age group will be visited by a station team who will focus on the same biblical story or text each week emphasizing the practice and how Christians lived it for centuries and we live it today.

DIG Refresh Crew will express themselves through

- ♦ creating with Creation Station Team
- ♦ drama in Holy Word Studio
- ♦ mission with Destination Discipleship Team
- ♦ Rhythm with Spirit Studio Team

Shepherds will return DIG Refresh Crew to the Sanctuary at 11:30 to reunite with families.
