



## February 15, 2023 Session Meeting Highlights

The following are the highlights from the February 15, 2023 Session meeting:

- The Interim Pastoral Care Pastor search team continues to look for promising candidates. They are ready to move to the second round of interviewing candidates.
- The Mission Coordinating Committee is planning a half-day retreat to set a vision for the Mission Team to clarify priorities and processes.
- The interior fire doors in the building will be unlocked when the office is open – except for those into the preschool corridors.
- Pastor Carter discussed his hopes for the coming year in his work with the Lombard Steering Committee, Session, and staff.
- Plans were discussed for the next Town Hall meeting in March.
- The Preschool (one of FPCA's ministries) will determine the feasibility of selling Spirit Cards. They will use the proceeds from the Spirit Card sales to update items and materials they use in their classrooms.
- Faith Formation opportunities for Lent 2023 were approved.
- The air conditioning systems in both the Choir Room and the Library will be replaced before summer at a cost of about \$51,000 (a large part of which is the cost for a crane to lift the choir room air conditions system on and off the roof).
- The rugs at the front of the Sanctuary used during COVID as "magic carpets" for the children will be removed as they may pose a tripping hazard now that we have returned to taking communion by intinction.
- A Worship Media Team is in the process of being formed to look into the needs of the sound system and screens for Fellowship Hall and the sanctuary.
