The walking tour of Bo-Kaap will include several highlights: Visit the Atlas Trading Co., a historic spice shop that has been serving the community for generations. Explore the wide variety of spices, herbs, and traditional ingredients used in Cape Malay cuisine.

Explore Monkeybiz, a unique craft store that supports local women from disadvantaged backgrounds. Admire the beautiful beadwork and handmade crafts while learning about the organization's mission and impact.

Take a trip to the Auwal Mosque, the first mosque established in South Africa. Learn about its historical significance and its role in the development of Islam in the country.

Enjoy a leisurely walk through the iconic Bo-Kaap Arch, a symbol of the neighbourhood's cultural diversity and heritage. Capture some memorable photos of the vibrant surroundings.

11:00 PM: Cooking Demonstration and Lunch.

After the tour, proceed to a local venue for a cooking demonstration and lunch featuring traditional Malay cuisine.

Experience the flavours and aromas of the Indian and Malay communities that have influenced Cape Malay cuisine for decades. Learn about the spices and techniques used in preparing dishes like roti and curry.
