Spioenkop Battlefield

The Spioenkop Battlefield, located in South Africa, is a historic site that holds significance for its role in the Second Anglo-Boer War, which took place between 1899 and 1902. The battle resulted in significant casualties on both sides and is known for its brutality and the challenging terrain.

Today, Spioenkop Battlefield is a historical site and memorial that attracts visitors interested in learning about this chapter in South African history. The site features well-preserved trenches, memorials, and informative displays that provide insight into the events of the battle.

The tour will cover typical farming systems in the summer rainfall area of South Africa with maize and soyabean the main cash crops, integrated with summer & winter cover crops, with livestock grazing on them. Since the tour will occur in the middle of winter (July), some of the cash crops might already be harvested or in a late matured phase, but some of the farmers and sites visited will have winter crops, such as winter cover crops with livestock integration, and winter wheat. However, most importantly will be meeting with the passionate people working at the sites and farms, such as farmers and researchers, sharing their stories and experiences.
