## Session 2 - Male Sexual Dysfunction

### **Erectile dysfunction**

14.10 – 14.40	Erectile dysfunction and oral treatment Definition of ED, diagnosis, prevalence, oral treatment.
14.40 – 14.55	Intracavernosal Injection Therapy Introduction to IC therapy, how to administer, specific patient instructions, how to store, adjust dosis, dosing, troubleshooting (variable responsiveness, pain, prolonged erection/priapism)
14.55 – 15.10	Penile Prosthesis Who are appropriate candidates, when to refer, what it is, how performed (high level), outcomes, recovery, satisfaction for patient and partner, sensitivity/orgasm, sexual function after surgery, and complications
15.10 – 15.40	Orgasmic and ejaculatory dysfunctions PE, delayed ejaculation. Definitions, prevalence and treatment pharmacological and non-pharmacological
15.40 – 16.10	HSDD and low testosterone Low testosterone in men / hypogonadism – diagnosis, symptoms with focus on sexual symptoms. Testosterone therapy: Appropriate candidates (brief), dosing, follow-up blood tests, assuring therapeutic range, expected outcomes, contra-indications / special groups (cardiac, prostate cancer)
