Columbus House Information to Donate Food or Service

Matthew 25:40 "...verily I say unto you, inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me."

The following are some suggestions for items that we bring to Columbus House. New rules from Columbus House require **no food prepared at home**.

All items should be dropped off in the church kitchen by **1:30 p.m.** on the 2nd Monday of the month. Please mark each item with your name and "Columbus House".

Ways to sign up to donate food or to prepare/serve dinner:

- 1. Sign up on the list posted on the bulletin board in the hallway.
- 2. Phone (203-795-9749) the church office (9:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m. weekdays) and tell us of your donation of food or service along with your phone number.
- 3. Email the church office at occhurch@snet.net with your first and second choice of food donation or with your interest to prepare/serve dinner. Please include your phone number.

Meatloaf: We purchase the meatloaves from Chip's Restaurant at the very discounted price of \$12.50 each. If you would like to contribute towards the purchase of meatloaves, please bring to the church your donation of cash or a check made out to "OCC" with "Columbus House" in the memo line. Or, mail a check to: Orange Congregational Church, 205 Meeting House Lane, Orange, CT 06477.

Ziti Pasta & Cheese – Four 16 oz. boxes and one small container of grated parmesan cheese - one sign up needed.

Red Pasta Sauce (no meat) – Two 45 oz. jars of tomato sauce or marinara sauce - 2 sign up's needed.

Green Salad: Purchase one large container of mixed greens, a container of cherry tomatoes, a few carrots and a cucumber along with one 15 - fl. oz. jar of Italian dressing - 2 sign up's needed.

Green Beans: Twelve 15 oz. cans – 2 sign up's needed.

Bread: 4 large loaves of **WHOLE WHEAT ONLY-** 1 sign-up needed.

Fresh Fruit: 20 servings. Soft fruit like bananas or oranges - 4 sign up's needed.

Dessert: 20 servings. **STORE BOUGHT ONLY**. i.e.: cookies, brownies, donut holes, cake, coffee cake.

Volunteers (4 people needed) – Arrive at Columbus House at 3 p.m. and leave about 6 p.m. *All servers must be at least 14* years of age *or in their freshmen year of high school;* Must be vaccinated for Covid; wear a mask, and <u>must fill out a volunteer form</u> (see office, church website, or Ted Mull).
