## Let's Practice:

## STEP 1

Phrase - Peter Peter Pumpkin Eater (make up your own)
Take the first letter of each word - pppe (you could use the another letter if you wanted to change it up - eeua)
This forms the core of your password - Don't forget to throw in a capital letter or two randomly.

## Let's Practice:

## STEP 2

Add 2 numbers (random number / part of your phone number / the day you got your pet). So now it looks like this
pPpe18
or could look like this 18 pPpe , or this 1 pPpe 8 or pP18pe

## STEP 3

Add some characters (2 more numbers) and we will use $3 \& 4$ with the shift key down.
pPpe18\#\$

## STEP 4

Something about the Website (first 3 letters) amazon

## pPpe18\#\$ama

or the lasts 3 letters looks like this
pPpe18\#\$zon
