



MUTTON BUSTIN' 2024

Mutton Bustin' Entry Fee: \$20.00 each - 3 to 7 years old

(Age on day of competition)

12 Sheep per night – rider can ride one night only.

To make it more convenient for parents/guardians, we have gone to online signup. **No phone entries will be accepted.** Sign-up form will be available July 10 at <https://lccfairgrounds.com/last-chance-stampede>.

Please Note:

- **Signing up does not automatically mean your child will be a rider. There will be a lottery drawing on Wednesday, July 17 for 12 riders each night.**
- **Only one entry per child accepted. Riders may ride only one time.**
- **If your child is chosen to ride, you will be notified by email.**
- Riders must ride on night they are assigned and may not change nights.
- You will need to bring a copy of original birth certificate and a copy of proof of health insurance to the Fairgrounds office along with your payment.
- Parent/guardian will be required to sign a release form at the time of payment. Parents/guardians are not allowed to register/sign releases for children not living in their household.

Schedule:

- Wednesday, July 10 – Online signup opens
- Monday, July 15 – Online signup closes at 5pm.
- Wednesday, July 17 – Lottery drawing for riders; riders will be notified via email
- Wednesday July 17 – Friday, July 19 – Rider registration and payment. Please bring copy of birth certificate and proof of insurance to the Fairgrounds office along with your payment.
- Friday, July 19, 5pm – Final day to complete registration and make payment. Failure to pay by this time, your spot will be forfeited and a new contestant will be chosen from the pool of entrants.

Requirements:

- 3 TO 7 YEARS OF AGE (on day of competition)
- Birth Certificate
- Proof of Health Insurance
- Signed Release Form
- Long sleeve shirt, long pants, shoes or boots (no open toes) are required for the safety of the rider. **Helmets are required and will be provided.**
- Only 1 parent/guardian will be allowed through the gate to the chutes. *This does not give you admittance to the rodeo.* You will need to purchase a ticket if you want to stay for the rodeo. Back numbers will be given upon payment which will allow 1 parent and rider access to chutes.
- Alcohol and/or drug abuse will not be allowed! If anyone, contestant or parent, is under the influence, they will be asked to leave the area immediately and the contestant's ride is forfeited. Entry fee will not be refunded.
- Foul language will not be tolerated as this is a children's event. If you fail to follow the above guidelines, the contestant will forfeit and no entry fee will be refunded.

Any rider not at the chutes at the start of their event, will forfeit their ride and the entry fee will not be refunded.

The West (main) gate must be used. **All contestants must be at West V.I.P. gate by 6:00 p.m. Competition will start at 6:30 p.m. each night.** May ride with two hands, but score will be lower by doing so. If rider begins with one hand, the free hand should not touch sheep or any part of your body or rider will be disqualified. Riders must stay on for 6 seconds.
