○ **SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

- ✓ Flares
- ✓ Fire Extinguisher
- ✓ Life Jackets (children 12 & under must wear them)
- ✓ Throwable Floatation Device

○ **GENERAL RULES**

- ✓ ALL PASSENGERS SHOULD REMAIN SEATED WHILE THE BOAT IS IN MOTION!
- ✓ Keep hands and feet inside the boat at all times.
- ✓ All non-motorized vessels have the right of way (kayaks, paddle boards, & sailboats).
- ✓ Docking is not permitted anywhere other than MDR Boat Rentals.
- ✓ No towing of water sports equipment, inflatables, toys or other vessels.
- ✓ Remove all trash upon completion of rental. (Cleaning fee = \$100)
- ✓ Turn sound system volume down when near dock.
- ✓ Operator must be able to speak and understand English well.
- ✓ Maritime law, which governs recreational boating, prohibits possession and/or use of marijuana in the harbor and on the ocean.
- ✓ If smoking cigarettes or cigars on boats, please ash over the side of the boat.
- ✓ Possession and/or use of drugs on boats, and operating boats while under the influence of drugs, is illegal and strictly prohibited.
- ✓ Operator may not consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol while operating boats.

○ **HARBOR RULES**

- ✓ Stay on the right side of the white and orange buoys.
- ✓ All non-motorized boats have the right of way (kayaks, paddle boards, & sailboats)
- ✓ Docking is not permitted anywhere other than MDR Boat Rentals.
- ✓ Swimming is not permitted in the marina.
- ✓ Fishing is not permitted in the marina.
- ✓ Stay at least 25 yards/meters away from the rocks or red/green buoys near the entrance and exit. Failure to do so can result in running the vessel aground.
- ✓ Stay at least 50 yards/meters away from other boats.
- ✓ Don't be an impediment to boat traffic, keep moving.
- ✓ Look out for floating kelp or other debris, hitting either can result in damage to the vessel.
- ✓ Always operate the boat at a speed that is comfortable for all passengers.
- ✓ ALL PASSENGERS SHOULD REMAIN SEATED WHILE THE BOAT IS IN MOTION!
- ✓ Keep hands and feet inside the boat at all times, do not hang limbs out of the windows and do not hang from the surray top bars.
- ✓ Do not remove the surray top or windows.
- ✓ Do not crawl, sit, or stand on the bow or stern of the boat.
- ✓ Any damages such as scratches to the fiberglass boat, punctures to the upholstery, missing windows or seat cushions will be charged against the damage deposit as well as cleaning fees.
