## Cultural Capital Week w/c December 15th 2025

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Student enrichment experiences are an essential part of our REACH curriculum, and I am pleased to confirm that the final week of term will offer students a rich blend of creative activities, on-site experiences and off-site trips. These sessions will give students the chance to develop new skills, broaden their horizons and celebrate the end of term in a positive way.

Between Monday and Wednesday next week, students will take part in a range of activities that they have selected, including Art, Catering, Cinema Experiences, Movies and Snacks, Pool Competitions, Gingerbread House Building, Karaoke and Games, along with several whole-day off-site adventures. All students will be on-site on the final day of term on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> December and as previously advised, students will be dismissed at 12.40pm.

As with previous enrichment events, all places for trips and sessions have been arranged, booked and paid for in advance. Attendance is therefore expected for all of the sessions your child has chosen. Off-site activities will depart school by 10am, and students must arrive promptly to ensure transport can leave on time; the transport will not be able to wait for late arrivals. Our free Breakfast Club will open from 8.45am as normal during Cultural Capital Week.

Students taking part in off-site activities should wear comfortable clothing suitable for active sessions. For certain activities (e.g. Ninja Warrior and Laser Tag), comfortable footwear is essential. All off-site groups will return to school at approximately 2.30pm, after which students will be dismissed in recognition of their full day of busy activity. On-site groups will finish at the same time.

Please see the top of the next page for a summary of the activities which will be running on each day. Lunch, refreshments and drinks will be provided, however there may be an opportunity for students to access other refreshments should they wish to bring a small amount of money themselves. This is optional and not necessarily required.
