



GCSE Results Update



We are pleased to update you on the GCSE Results students have been celebrating with us at REACH this morning. We congratulate our students on their achievements and thank our families and other stakeholders for the support they have also provided.

In a year where we became an oversubscribed school, were awarded "Skills Builder Gold" status and were shortlisted as finalists in team awards at both the National PRUsAP Awards and the Midlands Education Awards, initial analysis of the results shows that:

- 7% of our students passed seven or more Level 2 qualifications with 20% of students passing six or more Level 2 qualifications. In addition to this, 10% of our students passed eight qualifications in total.
- Despite joining us at different points in time and from different starting points, the majority of all of our students passed 3 or more Level 2 qualifications.
- Students have passed qualifications in a wide variety of subjects, including Art, Business Studies, Childcare, Combined Science, English, Hair and Beauty, Health and Social Care, History, Horticulture, Hospitality and Catering, Maths, Sport and Vehicle Systems Maintenance.

Headteacher Andy Wakefield said "I would like to congratulate our departing Year 11 students on their individual achievements and wish them well for the future; it has been a pleasure to work with them in my first few months in role. For us as a school, these results represent only the start of a journey in what will be a new and exciting era for REACH. We look forward to returning to work in September with an expanded staff team and a curriculum offer which has already been significantly broadened."
