



Kings Heath Train Station now open opposite REACH!



At the beginning of Summer Half-Term 1, the new Kings Heath train station opened directly opposite REACH. For anyone in our community who is not already aware, the station could not be closer to school and has transformed our transport links!

If you have not used the Camp Hill line previously, you can travel from Kings Heath to the city centre at Birmingham New Street or out towards Kings Norton. As a number of our partner schools are located in proximity to train stations which have connecting services which run from Birmingham New Street and Kings Norton, the opening of the station is already changing how students and visitors come to REACH. It is now also possible to travel directly to school from the new stations at Moseley and Pineapple Road.

As our student numbers continue to grow, we could not be more excited to be at the heart of a vibrant Kings Heath and a city whose transport systems are moving to another level in the coming years through the arrival of HS2 and the development of the tram network. All of this is in addition to the existing bus network which serves us extremely well as a school located on the High Street.
