## Curriculum intent



All students also benefit from non-externally examined lessons in Life Skills, and in Year 11 Pathways and Skills for Life.

Year 10s participate in Work Related Learning one day a week: they work towards qualifications in Motor Vehicle, Landscaping, Bricklaying, Hair and Beauty and Childcare.

Assemblies and tutorials in Numeracy and Literacy, Diversity and Inclusion, Topics and Skills Builder lead into Reflection time at the end of the school day.

Active Citizenship is central to REACH and students will develop higher moral thinking, helping them to understand their emotional responses and develop and practice prosocial skills.
