## Cleaning tips

When using Chalk paint or water-based paints, it is always advised to keep a bucket of clean water, a sponge and some rags nearby and wipe the surfaces as the project progresses.

If paint drips on carpeting, upholstery or clothes, try to pick it up with an almost dry sponge. Dab it. Do not rub.

For drips that have dried on moulding or other surfaces for a day or two, rub gently with methylated spirits so that the paint underneath is not removed. For dry paint on fabric, try a stain remover.

When using oil-based paints, keep a small container of turpentine and some soft, clean rags handy.

If drips are still wet, just wipe them up with a dry rag. If they are older than a day, use a soft rag dipped in turpentine. Stubborn drips may require a coarser rag or, as a last resort, a cotton swab dipped in acetone. Acetone is very strong and could remove paint underneath. Wipe over it with paint thinner to prevent the acetone from damaging the surface.

On clothing, dab the paint, while all the time turning the rag so that paint does not get put back onto the fabric. Do not rub the spot until the stain is close to being removed totally.

**Tip:** If paint is still wet, dishwashing liquid can be applied straight from the bottle. Rub in gently and leave for a while. Wash out normally.







# Japanese Blingy, Shiny, Sparkly Wood!

## How To:



### Shosugiban, Unicorn Spit and Resin

**Shosugiban** is an ancient Japanese technique used to bring out the grain of a piece of wood. It involves burning the wood to a char with a blow torch



The first step is to find yourself a piece of wood that already has a defined grain. Grab a gas torch, and a wire brush.



You now need to burn the surface of the wood to an absolute char, even it starts to crack a little that's fine. This is what it needs to get to before you find its beauty.



Once properly charred, start scrubbing the char away with your wire brush, eventually the only dark elements of the wood will be the grain.



Your grain should really pop now!



The next step is to choose some of the bright brights from the Unicorn Spit collection, Original colours.



Now put a few drops onto the wood using a single colour at a time and use your fingers to run the colour along the grain.

### Useful Tip:

Use spray bottle and spray a little water to dilute the Spit slightly and to facilitate easier blending.

# Now lets add a little bling to the mix, with Unicorn Spit Sparkling!

Sparkling works best when you use a Sparkling colour over any corresponding colours. For example, use Sapphire Swift (blue sparkling) over any of your blues. The Sparkling colours are translucent, and allow the base colour to come through whilst adding that touch of bling.



Once again, just a few drops of Sparkling over the corresponding base colour of Original Unicorn Spit. Sparkling Spit is really forgiving and even going outside of the lines looks so good!

Once my Spit was dry, I taped around the edges of the wooden board to create a 'dam'. Duct tape or brown packaging tape works well since it would be able to seal off any of the grooves, cracks and crevices that are found on the edge of the wood, and prevent the resin running out the sides.

For the resin, I used a 1:1 mix ratio of craft resin that is easily available at most specialist art and craft stores.


Follow the instructions that come with the product and be sure to wear latex gloves. This stuff is sticky and very hard to remove.

In this case mix the product, stirring really well and then let it stand for a few minutes to let as many of the air bubbles dissipate as possible. Make sure the piece of wood was on a level surface and as safe from dust, pet hair or anything else that may settle into resin as it dries.

Once you have poured the resin, it's going to be almost impossible to move the project to a new location.

Once poured; and where air bubbles appear, lightly go over them using your gas flame and they will quickly disappear. You may need to do this repeatedly, as the resin seeps into the wood, bubbles will form.

Now leave the project in peace, and let it cure overnight, after which you can carefully removed the tape, and voila....a beautiful shiny glass-like surface!

# DIY Room Makeover

Hi all you avid chalk painters,

Just Different is a company based in Brackenhurst, Alberton.

Recently, I partnered with Gwen De Sa (Renewed with Love) and Granny B to revamp a little girl's bedroom. We would like to share this project with you and take you through a step by step process as we transformed a Mermaid room into a Polka dot paradise fit for a princess.



## Products utilised for this project:

- Granny B's old fashion paint:
  - oX1, 1L Daisy White
  - oX2, 1L Mushroom Grey
  - oX1, 50ml Overcast Grey
  - oX1, 125ml Cotton Candy
  - oX1, 125ml Bubblegum Milkshake
  - oX1, 500ml Zinsser Bulls Eye 1.2.3 Primer
  - oX1, 1L Armour Matt Sealer

## • Other

- oX6 medium sponge rollers & x1 small sponge roller
- oMasking tape: x2
- oX4 Paint trays
- oSandpaper: X6 220 Grit

## Step 1:

Assess all your pieces and decide on the style and colour palette you want to use.

Customer Colour Palette: Light grey, slightly darker grey, white, pink, a hint of blue.

Style & Accessories: Polka dots/Ambre effect on doors and draws

Bed: Light grey carcass with white & darker grey polka dots

Side table: Grey with white and pink table tops and bottoms

Dressing Table & Chest of Draws: White carcass, light grey top with Pink, light grey and blue polka dots.



### Step 2:

Clean all the furniture with Handy Andy/sugar soap or Krudkutter and ensure all surfaces are 100% clean before starting.

Remove all hardware and clean thoroughly

Assess if any of your pieces might "Bleed", a yellow/brown stain that might occur on wood. We test this by either assessing the previous paint on the furniture or painting a layer of paint to see if any yellow or brown stains occur.

In this case only the small side table and chest of draws showed signs of "Bleeding" which then required us to paint 2 layers of Zinsser (Primer) to block the stains when painting the pieces.

You will need to leave these pieces for 7 days to cure



### Step 3:

Paint your pieces by utilising a foam roller. Due to the dark pink and blue colour of the bed and dressing table we were required to paint x3 layers of light grey to ensure effective coverage.

The bed was only painted in a light grey while the dressing table carcass was painted in white with a light grey top. Utilise you masking tape to seal off the areas when painting different colours on a piece.



### Step 4:

- The Bed: We wanted to give the illusion of "bubbles" floating across the head & foot board and decided to utilise the white and a slightly darker grey to achieve this effect without making the polka dots too dominant and deterring from the bedding that will be utilised.

- The Dressing Table: The same effect with "bubbles" floating from the side across the table top and onto the other side was utilised to tie in with the bed - Complimenting colours were brought in to tie in with the colour scheme of the bedroom

- To ensure you have effective stencilling without any bleeding the following process is suggested:

- o Utilise a piece of paper to remove excess paint from your brush

- o Ensure your stencil brush is not too wet (test this by dabbing the brush on the face of your hand to see the amount of paint that transfers).

- o If there is still too much paint, continue to remove the paint on your piece of paper and continue to test on your hand

- o Stencil by utilising either a circular motion or by tapping directly onto the stencil.

- o Continue process with all your colours



### Step 5 :

An Ambre effect was utilised on the door. To achieve this look the following process was utilised:

- Cotton Candy and Daisy white Chalk Paint

- A ratio of 50% & 50% Cotton Candy was mixed to create the transitioning colour between the Cotton Candy and White.

- Start by painting the darkest colour at the bottom

- Next, Paint your secondary colour

- Utilising a damp blending brush, blend the two colours together

- Paint the white at the top and repeat the process with the blended colour

- Continue to blend, dampening the brush with water until the desired effect is obtained.





### Step 6:

Give the bed and dressing table/doors etc. a light sand with a 220 grit sandpaper. Do not sand to hard as it might remove the paint and create a distressed look. If a distressed look is required, utilise a 100 grit sandpaper on certain areas to create the look you require.

Once all the pieces have been sanded ensure all the dust has been removed and seal your pieces.

A sponge roller can be utilised to complete this task.

Repeat the process and add an additional layer of sealer for added protection (This is not a requirement but always strongly recommended).

Allow your pieces to cure for at least 24 – 72 hours.

### Step 7:

After the 7 day curing process the Chest of draws and side table were painted.

A similar process was followed for both pieces starting from Step 3 – Step 6 with subtle changes.

- Side table:

- o Top: Painted in Cotton Candy
- o Arm and Legs: Painted in Mushroom Grey (Light Grey)
- o Bottom Shelf: Painted in Daisy White

- Chest of Draws:

- o Top: Painted in Mushroom Grey (Light Grey)
- o Carcass: Painted in Daisy White
- o Draws:

- ☒ Outside:

- Painted in an Ambre with the Cotton Candy on the bottom draw, Mixed lighter pink on the middle draw and Daisy White on the top draw
- Sides: Painted in Bubblegum Milkshake with floating “bubbles” in Cotton Candy and Overcast grey

- ☒ Handles:

- Handles were painted in Bubblegum Milkshake to complement the colour palette of the room.
- As the handles were fixed, Masking tape was used to tape around the bottom to eliminate painting onto the surface of the draws



I hope that you have enjoyed the step by step guide and that it has not just assisted but inspired you to take on a project of your own!!!

Always remember:

Furniture is only old and non-functional if you see it for what it is.

Look beyond its current state, get those creative juices flowing & give your furniture a new lease on life!!!!
