Girls Like You focuses on building self confidence, dismantling the ideas of unworthiness that could lead to at risk behaviors, and teaching a new foundation of healthy mindsets and healthy choices. Girls Like You, Inc. was among 17 other community providers selected to partner with the Juvenile Justice Commission of NJ's incentive to build a "Community Consortium of Providers".

Kelly is a champion for women and the rights of women, dedicating her time working with and volunteering for numerous organizations advocating for survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault and sex trafficking, black maternal wellness, just to name a few.

Kelly has mentored other female entrepreneurs, helping them with business start up, branding and development.
