Angel Tree is a ministry that helps incarcerated parents buy presents for their children. Make sure you've spoken with Barb or Gene Ferry or a representative before you make any purchases. You may also help by: distributing angels after service; making a cash donation or a check payable to Court Street United Methodist Church with Angel Tree Ministry on the memo line; shopping for gifts; organizing/ delivering gifts; or praying for the prisoners and their families.
