- 1 The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on May 20, 2015.
- 2 The name of the Company has been changed from 'Prozone Capital Shopping Centres Limited' to 'Prozone Intu Properties Limited' vide special resolution passed through postal ballot on 12th June, 2014. The Registrar of Companies, Mumbai has issued a fresh Certificate of Incorporation to this effect on 24th July, 2014, being the effective date of change of name of the company.
- 3 The figures of the last quarter ended March 31, 2015 and March 31, 2014 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the published year to date figures up to the third quarter of the relevant financial year.
- 4 The Company has revised depreciation rates on tangible fixed assets w.e.f. April 01, 2014 as per the useful life specified in the Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013 or as re-assessed by the Company. As prescribed in Schedule II, an amount of Rs.10.37 lacs (net of deferred tax) has been charged to the opening balance of retained earnings for the assets in respect of which the remaining useful life is NIL as on April 01, 2014. In respect of other assets on that date, depreciation has been calculated based on the remaining useful life of those assets. Had the Company continued with the previously applicable Schedule XIV rates, charge for depreciation for the current quarter and year ended on March 31, 2015 would have been lower and net profit would have been higher by Rs. 19.65 lacs and Rs. 80.60 lacs respectively.
- 5 Prior period item represents reversal of interest income amounting to Rs. 39.09 lacs which was erronously charged in the previous year.
- 6 Tax expense includes Current Tax and Deferred Tax.
- 7 Figures of the previous period / year have been reclassified/ regrouped wherever necessary.
- 8 The Company is mainly engaged in the business of designing, developing, owning and operating of Shopping Malls, Commercial and Residential Premises through its various SPVs. The Company is also providing management related consultancy services to its SPVs. There is no other reportable segment as per Accounting Standard (AS- 17).
