
AROMATHERAPY CLINICAL CERTIFICATION

ADVANCED PATHOPHYSIOLOGY

Included in this program is **Advanced Pathophysiology**, an extensive study of human pathological processes and their effects on homeostasis. Interrelationships among organ systems in deviations from homeostasis will be emphasized. Upon completion, students should be able to demonstrate a detailed knowledge of pathophysiology. Course topics include the etiology, physical signs and symptoms, prognosis, and complications of commonly occurring diseases and their management.

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. Explain the physiological processes the body uses to maintain homeostasis.
- 2. Describe the pathophysiological responses to infection, necrosis, stress, and carcinogenesis.
- 3. Discuss the causes and effects of diseases on various organ systems.
- 4. identify the compensation mechanisms that take place in response to trauma and disease.
