Spend time considering current world events, new advancements in the medical industry, and health concerns for the 21st century and how they relate to aromatherapy.

For example, you might want to research how essential oils are being used to treat or prevent diseases such as cancer, Parkinson's, or diabetes. Or, maybe you or a family member suffers from insomnia and you would like to know more about which essential oils can help. Other conditions, such as irritable bowel syndrome, or treating acne would make great topics. As you can see, the possibilities are endless. Keep in mind, you will want to write about topics that relate to the material we covered in the Aromatherapy Certification program.

Once you have an inkling of what you want to write about, submit your idea to me via email for approval. Once you get the green light, you have up to one year to complete your paper from the date of purchase. When writing your paper, please be sure to cite all material used.
